Glasgow West's Evening of Comedy at The Stand

Stand-up comedy and Amnesty International UK have a long history going all the way back to the first Secret Policeman's Ball fundraising galas in the late 1970s. There have been many events since them and local/student groups regularly organise such events in their communities. The Glasgow West Group recently held one of the most successful comedy fundraisers in a long time raising just over £3,500 for Amnesty International UK at a the event they held in Glasgow back in February.

£2,800 in ticket sales went directly to the Amnesty International UK Charitable Trust, a raffle and collection to support the work of the Glasgow West Amnesty group bought in an extra £750.

All performers gave their time free of charge in order to help raise awareness and funds in support of Amnesty International UK's ongoing work. The Stand Comedy Club in Glasgow generously provided free use of its premises for the evening.

During the interval, Mal, one of the local activists with Glasgow West Amnesty Group, provided the audience with a brief overview of the work of Amnesty International, and encouraged attendees to consider joining their local Amnesty Group.

"It was an amazing evening! We couldn't believe we also sold out all of our raffle books! People were incredibly generous despite local hardships. We have already fixed our date for next year's comedy event at The Stand, who we'd like to thank for their work in supporting and hosting the event."
