Comedy with a Conscience in Cardiff

We have been delighted to see many groups organise excellent live comedy fundraisers this year. The latest is one of the biggest and a regular event that has been running for several years now. The Cardiff Amnesty Group have organised events in the past focusing on Nazanin and Anoosheh and this year they kept their focus on people being unjustly imprisoned in Iran. Tomos, a member of the Cardiff Group wrote up a summary of this year's event:

"Cardiff Amnesty's acclaimed 'Stand Up in the Park' comedy event returned to Sophia Gardens, Cardiff for a fifth year in July, with leading comedians Clint Edwards, Esther Manito, Micky Overman and Daliso Chaponda headlining.

"Organised in partnership with Everyman Theatre Cardiff, this powerful "comedy with a conscience" event continued on the theme of previous years in calling for the immediate and unconditional release of British nationals arbitrarily jailed in Iran.

"The Group received half of the profits from the event and ran a raffle, fundraising a total of £2,350. There was also the opportunity to raise awareness of the plight of individuals arbitrarily detained in Iran and the Group received over 30 signatures on letters asking the Foreign Secretary to do more to secure their release.

"The event's main focus was on Morad Tahbaz and Mehran Raoof, both of whom remain detained in Iran, and the Cardiff Amnesty Group now calls on all members to sign the ongoing petition calling for Morad's release."
