Bournville Amnesty Group recently got in touch to tell us about their incredible, annual live music event that continues to go from strength to strength. The Celebration Concert for Human Rights took pace back in December to mark Human Rights Day. John from the group told us how the event came together to be such a success:

"It's organised by Bournville group members who over the years, continue to build a network of performers. All the artists donate their time and talent to the event and to the movement. Likewise, our friend who lends and sets up the sound system. Martin runs a slide show featuring the Write for Rights prisoners as a backdrop.

"In a room next to the main hall we set up the Candlelight Café. Open with delicious cakes before and after the concert, there are information stalls and a Write for Rights signing stall where Astrid gathers lots of signatures. Gill sells crafts and foods from Bethlehem. Last year we also had a raffle for a beautiful, handmade dress donated by Nicky which she bought on a trip to Hebron in 2014."

"For the last few years, it has taken place in The Friends Meeting House in Bournville. The Cadbury family founded Bournville around the chocolate factory in what is now a conservation area. Quaker friends were involved in setting up the Bournville AI group in 1962. In the early days, members gathered at each other's houses but eventually met at the Friends Meeting House where our monthly meetings continue after some 60+ years.

"Funds raised, are shared equally with Freedom From Torture which after a break of some years now has a new growing volunteer support group. Some of us are in both!

"The concert raises around £900 in all but, more importantly, it raises awareness and lifts the spirits and motivation of the activist members."
