

URGENT ACTION

PRISONER OF CONSCIENCE GRANTED MEDICAL CARE

Malukan prisoner of conscience, Johan Teterissa, was granted medical treatment by prison authorities for a condition affecting both his legs and hindering his movement.

Malukan prisoner of conscience, **Johan Teterissa**, was granted access by prison authorities to medical treatment in February. An external specialist examined the condition that has been causing Johan Teterissa severe pain in both of his legs and hindering his ability to walk for over two months and provided him with treatment. He received one round of dosage for his condition but will require further treatment in future.

Amnesty International continues to call for his immediate and unconditional release and pending this, for prison authorities to ensure he continues to be granted access to adequate and free medical treatment.

Thank you to all those who sent appeals. No further action is requested from the UA network.
