

Amnesty International UK Governance Taskforce (GTF)
Update, 1 November 2013

The GTF met again on 12 October and received reports from each of the sub-groups. So far we have mainly been identifying what structures exist and their inter-connections; what 'rules' govern both AIUK and the International movement; and how AI communicates with and consults members. This may not sound like much, but believe me, the sub-groups have been working very hard and even defining 'members' isn't easy.

We are next due to meet on 16 November and have agreed that we will concentrate on prioritising the various strands of work, identifying what recommendations will be appropriate eg for the next board meeting and the 2014 AGM. We are working on a timeline of key delivery dates, which we will publish shortly.

Additionally, we have received some questions from members and have agreed to produce a Q&A document which we can update during the life of the Taskforce.
